When we think about September what comes to our minds is Labor Day. The first Labor Day was held in 1882 and it became a federal holiday in 1894. It was originally intended that the day would be filled with a street parade to allow the public to appreciate the work of the trade and labor organizations. One of the reasons for choosing to celebrate this on the first Monday in September was to add a holiday between July 4th and Thanksgiving. But, do you realize this is also the same month that our U. S. Constitution was ratified? It was ratified on September 17, 1787. Of the thirty-nine men that officially brought the United States government into existence, there is quite an array of them that were Freemasons.
