Each of the York Rite degrees has its own special character and teaches important lessons in Masonry. However, the Commandery Orders are something set apart from anything you have experienced. They are very different in character. The first of the Orders is the Order of the Red Cross. It takes place during the time of the Babylonian captivity before the building of the Second Temple. At the end of the evening, a new order of knighthood has been created, dedicated to truth. At this point the stage is set for everything that is to follow in the next Orders. Before you are created a Knight of Malta, you will be invested with the Mediterranean Pass and learn the history of this Order of Knighthood. Finally, the Order of the Temple is conferred; the only true "Christian" Order. This Order is the longest, most impressive and involved in Masonry. It ask the candidate to examine his life in the light of his call to life of integrity, honor and service.

The Commandery actively supports three national philanthropies; The Knight Templar Eye Foundation, the Knight Templar Educational Fund and the Holy Land Pilgrimage for Christian Ministers.
