2. (The C. of H. forms the groups of threes, starting with the R.A.C. at the east point of the first triangle, and continues to form threes as he moves counter clockwise around the circle. If there are exactly threes without the C. of H., he returns to his place. If there are two extras [himself and the P.S.], they will stand in their place. If there are exactly threes, including the C. of H., he will assume a place in the last three, and report.)

Suggested approach to interlocking arms when forming the groups of threes:

Step 1. Each of the three places his left forearm horizontally across his chest, palm down.

Step 2. Pivot the left arm at the elbow until left palm is over left wrist of the companion on his right.

Step 3. Close left hand, gripping left wrist of the man on the right.

Step 4. Slightly lower mutually gripped left arms.

Step 5. Each of the three place the right forearm across his chest, palm down.

Step 6. Pivot the right arm at the elbow until the right palm is over the right wrist of the Companion on the left.

Step 7. Close the right hand, gripping right wrist of the man on the left.

Suggested approach to forming the Feet and interlocking arms when forming the groups of 3  
First place the Left feet heel to toe so the 3 feet from an Equilateral Triangle.

Then interlock arms as follows

Step 1. Each of the three places his left forearm horizontally across his chest, palm down.

Step 2. Pivot the left arm at the elbow until left palm is over left wrist of the companion on his right.

Step 3. Close left hand, gripping left wrist of the man on the right.

Step 4. Slightly lower mutually gripped left arms.

Step 5. Each of the three place the right forearm across his chest, palm down.

Step 6. Pivot the right arm at the elbow until the right palm is over the right wrist of the Companion on the left.

Step 7. Close the right hand, gripping right wrist of the man on the left.

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
