- c) Cordons (also called "fourrageres" or "aiguillettes") shall be worn as follows:
- (1) Past District Deputy Grand Commanders - Red
 - (2) District Instructors and Members of the Committee on Work - White
 - (3) Inspector General - Yellow
 - (4) Past Grand Officers (other than Past Grand Commander) - Alternate rows of Red and Gold
 - (5) Any braided cord will be worn under the arm with plain cords outside the arm as specified in the Manual of Public Ceremonies.

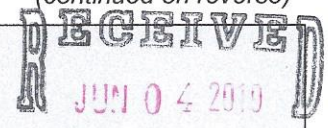
DELETE entire subparagraph (c) and replace with the following:
