LANGUAGE TO BE AMENDED (words to be deleted are underlined.)

Chapter 10. Chivalric Districts and District Deputy Grand Commanders.

10.01. Chivalric Districts.

The Grand Commander shall divide this Grand Jurisdiction into such number of Chivalric Districts as to him may seem desirable and appoint a Deputy to each of said Districts. Such Deputies shall be Present or Past Commanders of a Commandery under this grand jurisdiction, and shall be charged to use all proper effort to increase the interest in Chivalric Masonry in their respective districts. The Deputies shall make such reports and at such times as the Grand Commander may direct. They shall have such other duties and powers as are provided in the Constitution of the Grand Commandery and these Regulations.

NEW LANGUAGE

Change the language currently in Section 10 Chivalric Districts and District Deputy Grand Commanders, 10.01 Chivalric Districts, to read as follows:

Chapter 10. Chivalric Districts and District Deputy Grand Commanders.

10.01. Chivalric Districts.

The Grand Commander shall divide this Grand Jurisdiction into such number of Chivalric Districts as to him may seem desirable and appoint a Deputy to each of said Districts. Such Deputies shall be Past Commanders of a Commandery under this grand jurisdiction, and shall be charged to use all proper effort to increase the interest in Chivalric Masonry in their respective districts. The Deputies shall make such reports and at such times as the Grand Commander may direct. They shall have such other duties and powers as are provided in the Constitution of the Grand Commandery and these Regulations.

Discussion: This resolution conforms section 10.01 of Chapter 10 with the legislative changes advanced in the resolution changing Article V, Section 2, of the Constitution.
