What is a Council of Allied Masonic Degrees?

The Allied Masonic Degrees are an invitational organization, and requires membership in the Royal Arch as well as the Symbolic Lodge. Membership is limited to 27 members per council.

The Allied Masonic Degrees are detached degrees some of which, many years ago, were conferred under Craft warrants and formed part of the then loosely governed Freemasonry of the period. Many of these detached degrees became dormant in some places, although in others they were conferred as side degrees. In time, the better of these degrees were grouped together in an organized body under the title of Allied Masonic Degrees.

The degrees comprising the system in our Jurisdiction in the U.S.A. are the Royal Ark Mariner, Secret Monitor, Knight of Constantinople, Saint Lawrence the Martyr, Architect, Superintendent, Grand Tilers of Solomon, Master of Tyre, Excellent Master, Installed Sovereign Master, Installed Commander Noah, Red Branch of Eri and Ye Ancient Order of Corks. They are conferred in the United States in Councils chartered by the Grand Council. Each Council is limited to twenty seven members, with two exceptions. One of these Councils is known as the Council of the Nine Muses and is limited to nine members. The other is the Grand Masters Council, which has what is known as a roving charter. The purpose of the latter Council is to provide a place of membership in the Allied Masonic Degrees for brethren residing in localities where Councils have not been organized. Membership in every Council of Allied Masonic Degrees is by invitation, and is predicated on membership in the Royal Arch Chapter.

What is the Order of Knight Masons?

Knight Masonry is a chivalric fraternal Masonic Order which confers three Degrees of high symbolic, philosophical and moral value. These Masonic Degrees continue the story of the Temple in Jerusalem and in an Irish context completes the Masonic Legend of the Temple.

The Degrees in Knight Masonry are:

The Red Cross of Daniel or The Babylonian Pass referred to as Knight of the Sword.
The Jordan Pass referred to as Knight of the East.
The Royal Order referred to as Knight of the East and West.

Plus the Degree of Installed Excellent Chief for a Sir Knight elected to preside over a Council.

While the subject matter of these degrees can be found within various Masonic Orders around the world, only in the Irish working under the Grand Council of Knight Masons are they communicated in the most detail and in their complete and correct form.

The content of the Degrees seems to be as old as Freemasonry itself and for centuries it has been regarded as a vital part of the Masonic Journey.

The Grand Council of Knight Masons was formed in 1923 to preserve, practice and perpetuate these degrees, the duty having been previously held by the Supreme Grand Encampment (now the Great Priory of Ireland).

Today the Order of Knight Masons is rapidly growing in membership with the ever developing presence of Councils around the globe.

Who can join?

Any Master Mason, who is also a Mark Master Mason and Royal Arch Mason in good standing, may after one year become a Knight Mason. Those who qualify must be invited, although they are encouraged to enquire.

If a potential candidate is unsure of whom to ask, he should begin with the Recorder of his Royal Arch Chapter or contact the Grand Scribe's office for details of a Council in his area.
