LANGUAGE TO BE AMENDED (deleted, changed, etc.)

d) Braided shoulder cords (also called "fourrageres" or "aiguillettes") shall be worn as follows:

(1) Current Inspector General – Yellow

(2) Current District Instructors – White

(3) Past Grand Officers (other than Past Grand Commander) – Alternate rows of Red and Gold

NEW LANGUAGE

(d) Current and Past Inspectors General shall be entitled to wear an authorized solid yellow bar directly above the left breast pocket welt and to the right of any other Templar meritorious ribbons.

(e) Current and Past District Instructors shall be entitled to wear an authorized solid white bar directly above the left breast pocket welt and to the right of any other Templar meritorious ribbons.

(4) Any braided cord will be worn under the arm with plain cords outside the arm as specified in the Manual of Public Ceremonies.

e) The Black Dress Uniform must be worn when performing the Jesse E. Ramsdell Trophy Competition and the Richard John Carr Trophy Competition by all officers (with the exception of the Prelate who may wear a Prelate's Robe) involved in performing the Commandery Opening Competitions.

NEW LANGUAGE

(continued from front)

(f) Past Grand Officers (other than Past Grand Commander) shall be entitled to wear an authorized red and yellow bar and to the right of any other Templar meritorious ribbons.

g) The Black Dress Uniform must be worn when performing the Jesse E. Ramsdell Trophy Competition and the Richard John Carr Trophy Competition by all officers (with the exception of the Prelate who may wear a Prelate's Robe) involved in performing the Commandery Opening Competitions.

EXPLANATION

Removes the previous section (d) description and requirements of braided shoulder cords worn on uniform, and replaces with new language adopting an equivalent solid bar in its place. This brings uniform into conformity with current Florida Knight Templar custom.
