- Each proposed amendment shall recite in detail the section number and full title of the section proposed to be amended.
- Each proposed amendment shall be filed with the Grand Recorder in writing not later than February 1_{st} of each year.

The Grand Recorder shall have same duplicated and a copy mailed or e-mailed to each Grand Commandery Officer, each Past Grand Commander, each District Deputy Grand Commander, and the Recorders of all Constituent Commanderies so that said amendment shall reach each Grand Commandery Officer, each Past Grand

Commander, each District Deputy Grand Commander, and the Recorders of all Constituent Commanderies by March 1st of each year. Said proposed amendment shall be read at the next Stated Conclave of each Constituent Commandery, and after consideration, the Commandery may instruct its delegates as to how they shall vote on the subject. Any proposed amendment so made shall be read and referred to the Committee on Jurisprudence. Said Committee shall report thereon, and, if the amendment is carried by a two-thirds vote of the Grand Commandery, the same shall be declared adopted.

DISCUSSION AND LEGAL ANALYSIS:

This is a "housekeeping" resolution designed to bring into coordination with ALL THREE Florida Grand York Rite Bodies identical deadline dates for the submittal of resolutions to amend the three respective Constitutions and Regulations, and the later distribution to constituent bodies and others as specified within the three respective Constitutions and Regulations. The goal is to streamline the receipt and disbursement of legislation to one set of common dates to make the job of the Grand Secretary/Recorder less burdensome in following the constitution, rules, and regulations concerning "Amendments."

IMPORTANT: THIS IS A RESOLUTION FORMALLY BEING PRESENTED TO OVERTURN THE NEGATIVE SECOND VOTE TAKEN AT THE LAST GRAND CONCLAVE ON RESOLUTION #2023-03, BECAUSE IT WAS IN VIOLATION OF THE GRAND COMMANDERY'S CONSTITUTION, AND REINSTATE THE FIRST VOTE THAT WAS PROPERLY TAKEN ON THE FLOOR TO ORIGINALLY APPROVE.

A] What happened at the 2023 Grand Conclave:

Because of the manner in which the legislative resolutions (#'s 2023-03 and 2023-04) were handled, the members of Grand Commandery were disenfranchised by the outcome of the second vote on these resolutions, which we assert was taken in violation of the Grand Commandery of Florida's Constitution.

On the first ballot, Resolutions # 2023-03 and #2023-04 were approved. On the second ballot taken, both resolutions were defeated.

B] Legal analysis:

The Grand Constitution of the Grand Commandery of Florida states as follows below, as concerns who is considered a member of the Grand Commandery and entitled to a vote therein. Please note that Article II, Section 2 <u>includes</u> Past Commanders of Florida Commanderies (holders of the "white" ballot cards) as members of this Grand Commandery. This is highlighted below *in bold italics*.

ARTICLE II Grand Officers, Members, and Titles

Section 2. Members.

This Grand Commandery is and shall be composed of the following members:

a) All Past Grand Commanders, Past Deputy Grand Commanders, Past Grand Generalissimos, and Past Grand Captains General.

- b) The Commander, Generalissimo, and Captain General of each Constituent Commandery in this Grand Jurisdiction.
- c) The Grand Prelate of the Grand Commandery.
- d) All Past Commanders of its Constituent Commanderies.
- e) All Past Commanders who may have Demitted from another jurisdiction and who shall have been elected to membership in this Grand Commandery, after having presented satisfactory proof of their former membership in a Grand Commandery; together with proof of their rank in same; or who have become Dual Members of a Florida Constituent Commandery.
- f) All Knights Templar of other Grand Commanderies who have been elected Honorary Members. Such Honorary Membership may be conferred by majority vote of this Grand Commandery upon distinguished Chivalric Masons regardless of affiliation, but shall not confer the right to vote.
- g) Membership in this Grand Commandery is contingent upon a sustained membership in a Constituent Commandery hereof.

Further, it specifies in Article II, Section 3, the following below concerning proxies. Please note that a Past Commander of a Florida Commandery, who is also carrying a proxy, is entitled to two votes, consisting of his proxy vote AND his personal vote. That provision is highlighted below *in bold italics*. Note the conforming language in Article III, Section 5, Paragraph 1 (a), which is also highlighted further below *in bold italics*.

Section 3. Proxies.

a) Proxies shall be held to be lawful in the Grand Commandery of Florida. Any voting member of this Grand Commandery may be designated by one or more of the three Principal Officers of the Commandery to which he belongs, to act as his or their proxy. No person may act or vote for another unless he shall present to the Grand

Recorder, or Committee on Returns and Credentials, a Proxy duly signed by the absentee voting member, and attested by the seal of the Commandery which is being so represented. *Pursuant to this, the representative will be entitled to cast his own vote plus one vote for each duly executed and filed proxy, as provided above.*

b) Should it become necessary for a Sir Knight carrying a Proxy to prove he is in good standing, the Committee on Returns and Credentials is required to accept as proof a good standing voucher from the Grand Recorder, which shall not be unreasonably withheld, whereupon ballots must be issued.

Further, we reproduce "Article III, Grand Conclaves, Section 5. Votes and Manner of Voting" below, where it further describes the manner of voting as follows:

Section 5. Votes and Manner of Voting.

- a) Each member of the Grand Commandery present, in person or a proxy for a Constituent Commandery representative, will be entitled to cast his own vote plus one vote for each duly executed and filed proxy as prescribed above.
- b) All questions before the Annual Conclave, unless otherwise provided by Grand Encampment Law, shall be decided by a majority vote of those present. Affirmative votes are to be signified by verified voters extending the sword arm; Negative votes are to be signified by verified voters extending the bridle arm. In case of a tie, the Presiding Officer shall cast the deciding vote.

HOWEVER, for the purposes of voting on legislation to change the Constitution, Rules and regulations, which is the provision we are mainly concerned with, is Article X Amendments. You will note that these resolutions must be passed by a two-thirds vote. That provision is highlighted below *in bold italics* at the end of Article X. We reproduce Article X Amendments in its entirety below:

The Grand Recorder shall have same duplicated and a copy mailed or e-mailed to each Grand Commandery Officer, each Past Grand Commander, each District Deputy Grand Commander, and the Recorders of all Constituent Commanderies at least forty-five days prior to the next Annual Conclave. Said proposed amendment shall be read at the next Stated Conclave of each Constituent Commandery, and after consideration, the Commandery may instruct its delegates as to how they shall vote on the subject. Any proposed amendment so made shall be read and referred to the Committee on Jurisprudence. Said Committee shall report thereon, and, if the amendment is carried by a two-thirds vote of the Grand Commandery, the same shall be declared adopted.

Please take note that nowhere in any of the Constitutional provisions does it say that Past Commanders are not entitled to vote on amendments to the Constitution, Rules and Regulations of this Grand Commandery. (That is, prohibiting those holding "white" ballot cards from voting on these resolutions.) To reiterate: The text we have highlighted above *in bold italics* is the provision in Article X that governs both the first and the second round of balloting on the resolutions, where we assert that the second round of balloting was in violation of the Grand Commandery's Constitution.

To summarize our position, based on the above facts: "[T]he "Grand Commandery," as specified in the last sentence of Article X Amendments reproduced above, consists of its members. Its members are described in Article II, Section 2, also as reproduced above. Its members include

C} Our position concerning this issue:

We maintain that the first set of votes on these two resolutions presented were properly balloted upon in accordance with our Grand Constitution. The Grand Commander then declared Resolutions # 2023-03 and 2023-04 adopted.

When Past Department Commander Robert Burleson later stood up and complained that Past Commanders (holders of the "white" voting cards) had no vote respecting the adoption or rejection of these resolutions to change the Constitution, Rules and Regulations of this Grand Commandery, this was an erroneous position on his part. We maintain that the second set of votes on the resolutions, per the demand of Robert Burleson, was irregular and in violation of our Constitution, rendering that second set of votes "void ab initio," thereby confirming that the first set of votes were properly and legally handled.

D] Adoption of this resolution will authorize the following result:

Consequently, adoption of this resolution by the voting members of Grand Commandery will confirm that Resolution # 2023-03 was properly balloted upon on the first vote undertaken, that this was indeed the legal outcome of the original balloting undertaken before Past Department Commander Burleson demanded the second vote, and that this resolution voids
