LANGUAGE TO BE AMENDED (deleted, changed, etc.)

C. A Companion who has been a Royal Arch Mason in good standing for a period of forty or more years, and who has not been disciplined, suspended nor expelled for an offence involving moral turpitude, and if twenty-five years of such service have been in a Florida Chapter or Chapters, shall be exempt from fifty per cent (50%) Grand Chapter annual per capita tax, dues, and assessments.
